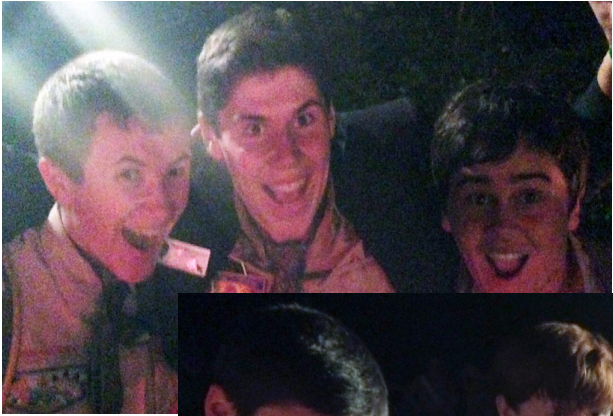

Training Begins at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00. Refer to your Passport for information on Training Session Locations.

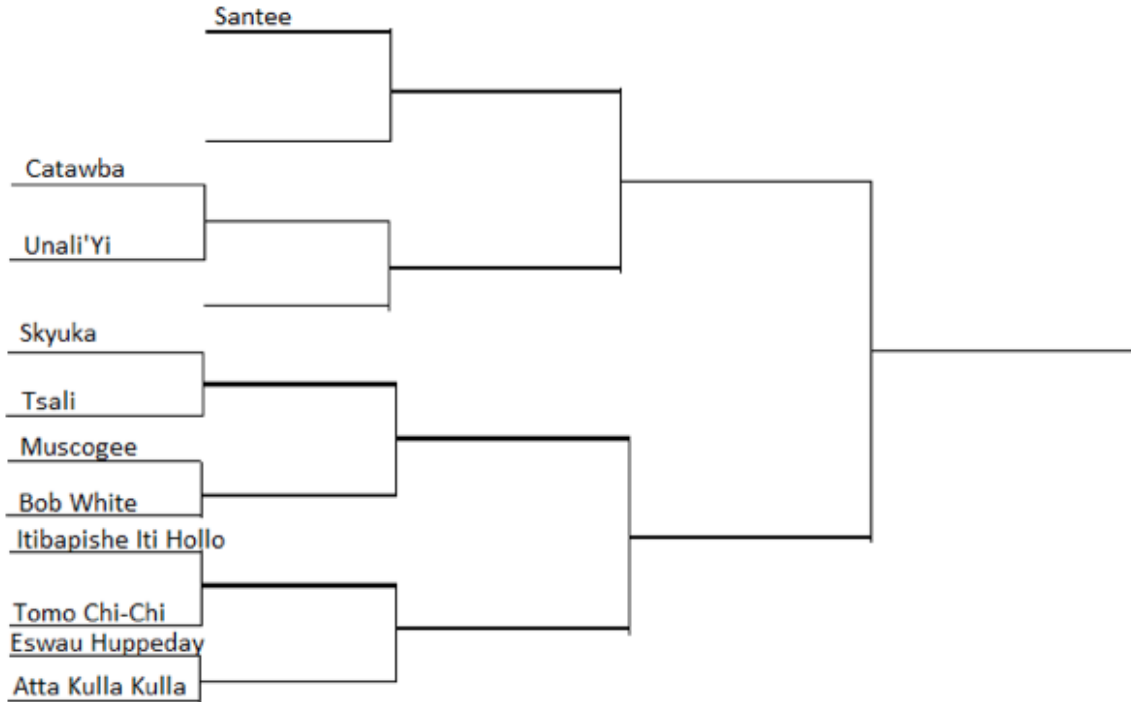

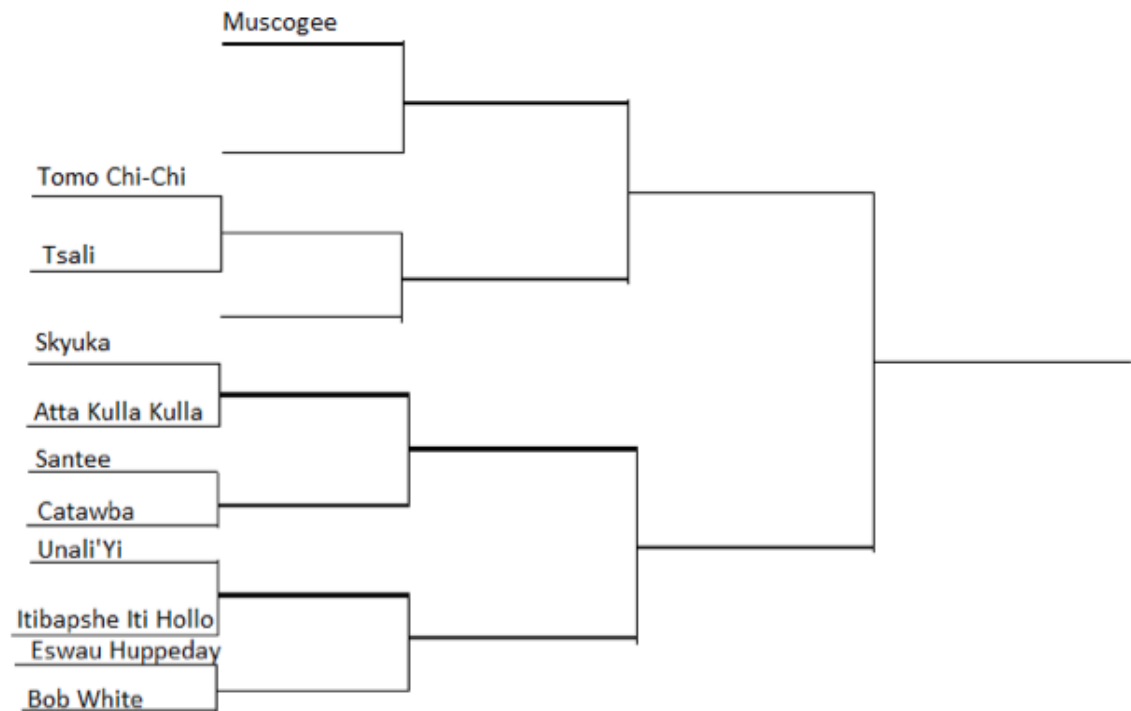
